



Does the tour take place in English?

Oui ! Each guide speaks English fluently.

Can we stop to take pictures?

Yes - weather and security permitting.

How many wines are tasted during our Wine & Voyages tour?

- Tour 1 Côte de Nuits 2:30 pm - one stop with 4 to 5 wines tasted (often more), red and white.
- Tour 2 Extended Côte de Nuits 10 am - two stops with 8 to 10 wines tasted (often more), red and white.

Can I buy wine?

Yes, but there is no obligation to do so. The purchase of wine for shipment to the United States and Japan is possible in the wine houses visited.

Will I see the Romanée Conti?

Yes ! Every tour stops to see the Romanée Conti field where the grapes are grown.

Can we taste the Romanée Conti?

Unfortunately, it is not possible to taste the Romanée Conti.

Will I see the Clos de Vougeot castle?

Yes ! Every tour stops to see the Clos de Vougeot castle and take pictures but we skip the interior as there are no wine tastings at the castle.

What time do we return to Dijon?

- Tour 1 Côte de Nuits - return between 4:30 & 5 pm
- Tour 2 Extended Côte de Nuits 2 winery stops - return between 1 & 1:30 pm

Can I be dropped off elsewhere than Dijon?

1. Nuits Saint Georges - Yes
2. Wine village of the Côte de Nuits (Vosne, Chambolle, Vougeot, Gevrey, Marsannay) - Yes
3. Beaune - no but we can drop you at the Nuits St Georges train station where there are many trains to Beaune.

Can I take my baggage in the minivan?

Yes ! We provide lots of space in the trunks of our minivans.

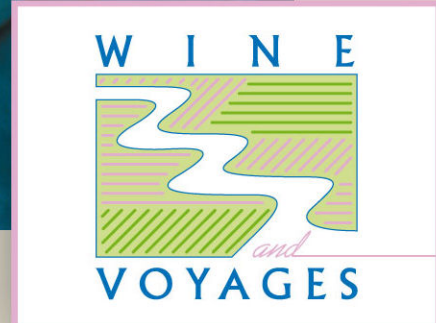

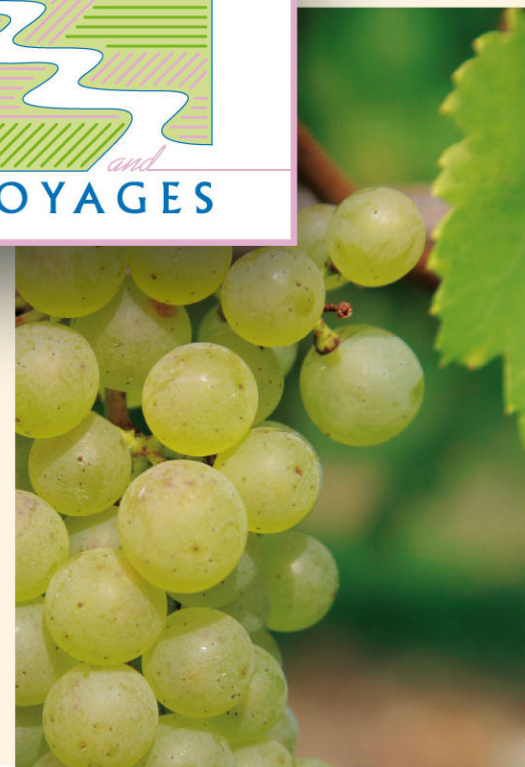

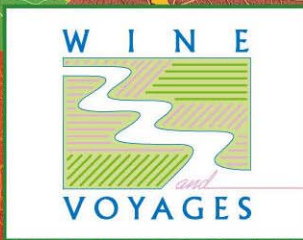

CIRCUIT VITICOLE

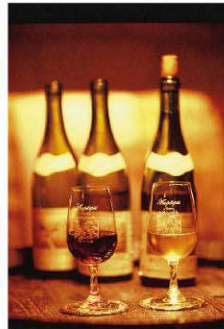


Votre clef de la Bourgogne viticole depuis 1992

Rejoignez les spécialistes des circuits viticoles bourguignons à la découverte de cette région légendaire. Profitez de l'expérience des guides viticoles « Wine & Voyages » pour découvrir la Bourgogne et ses vins d'exception. Après le circuit commenté dans les vignes de Marsannay, Fixin, Gevrey Chambertin, Morey Saint Denis, Chambolle Musigny, Vougeot, Vosne Romanée et Nuits St Georges, vous dégusterez quelques vins des grands villages de la Côte de Nuits et souvent de la Côte de Beaune lors de visites de caves. Deux circuits au choix :

Tour 1 : Côte de Nuits – départ 14 h 30, durée 2-2 1/2 heures, prix : 53 € par personne

- Circuit en Côte de Nuits sur les petits chemins de vignes et la Route des Grands Crus, commenté par votre guide viticole bilingue.
- Comprendre notre terroir, apprécier les villages mythiques et voir les parcelles de vignes qui produisent les vins parmi les plus chers au monde.
- Visite de cave d'élevage de vin accompagnée des explications de votre guide sur la vinification bourguignonne.
- Initiation à la dégustation et mise en pratique avec une dégustation des grands vins chardonnay et pinot noir de Bourgogne.



Tour 2 : Côte de Nuits matin, 2 arrêts dégustation – 10 h, durée 3-3 1/2 heures, prix : 64 € par personne

- Circuit approfondi en Côte de Nuits sur les petits chemins de vignes et la Route des Grands Crus, commenté par votre guide viticole bilingue.
- Nous partons sur la base du Tour 1, Côte de Nuits (voire descriptif) avec un premier arrêt dans une maison de vin en Côte de Nuits avec visite de cave suivie d'une dégustation comparative.

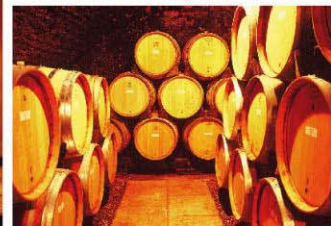

- We build on the foundation of Tour 1, Côte de Nuits (see above), enjoying the Côte de Nuits with a commented cellar visit and a comprehensive wine tasting.

• To go more in depth, with the help of your burgundy wine specialist, compare two wine houses and wine-making styles when you visit a second winery and taste several wines of their production. A rare occasion to become a wine critic!
